During his life, Gregor Mendel visited Vienna many times. He studied biology and physics at the University of Vienna in the early 1850s, but his attempts to pass the teaching examination failed. This virtual science walk will highlight several sites in Vienna that are associated with Gregor Mendel and serve as icons conveying his outstanding contributions to the present day. Starting from the site of the "rediscovery" of Mendel's laws of heredity, today's Gregor Mendel Street, the walk will lead past an almost forgotten Mendel monument, revisit his teachers at the University of Vienna, and finally end at the Gregor Mendel Institute which carries Gregor Mendel's legacy into the future.
